One of the scholars pointed out, before trying to avoid plagiarism, we must tackle the causes which include: the lack of academic integrity, the student's ignorance, their difficulty with citing, in addition to the weakness in language skills. The University of California, at Devise explains that the effects of plagiarism are ranging from damaging the student's academic career and causing serious legal problems to the institution's reputation.

The policies detailing the guidelines on problems of plagiarism that have been established should be explained by teachers periodically. Whenever ideas or works are borrowed from another source, students must cite or quote that source. This is the best way to minimize plagiarism.
