Mohamed El Baradei is the director general of the International Atomic Energy Agency(IAEA) ,an international organization that is part of the United Nations system.He was one of five children of Mostafa El Baradei,an attorney **who** headed the Egyptian Association.El Baradei's father was also a supporter of democratic rights in Egypt supporting a free press and independent Judiciary.

Mohamed's diplomatic career began in 1964 in the ministry of External affairs, **where** he served in the permanent missions of Egypt. El Baradei began to serve as director General of the IAEA which is based in Vienna on 1 December. He was elected for two more year terms in 2001 and 2005.His tenure has been marked by high profile and non-proliferation issues **which** include the inspections in Iraq.

In October 2005,Dr El Baradei and the IAEA were jointly awarded the Nobel Prize for "efforts to prevent nuclear energy from being used for military purposes and to ensure that nuclear energy for peaceful purposes is used in the safest possible way! ".In addition, he has received multiple other awards for his work.These include the International four Freedoms award from Roosevelt Institute.His main role has always been the preservation of peace throughout the world.Besides, **he** has settled several crucial world political issues .He still defends equity, understanding and above all cooperation.
